Howard Greenberg, of New York's [Howard Greenberg Gallery](#), is showing part of his archival photography collection at Paris's [Henri Cartier-Bresson Foundation](#) beginning early April through April 21 (two days before I was to arrive — more about this later), in an exhibition that originates at the [Musée de l'Élysée](#) photography museum in Lausanne, Switzerland.
