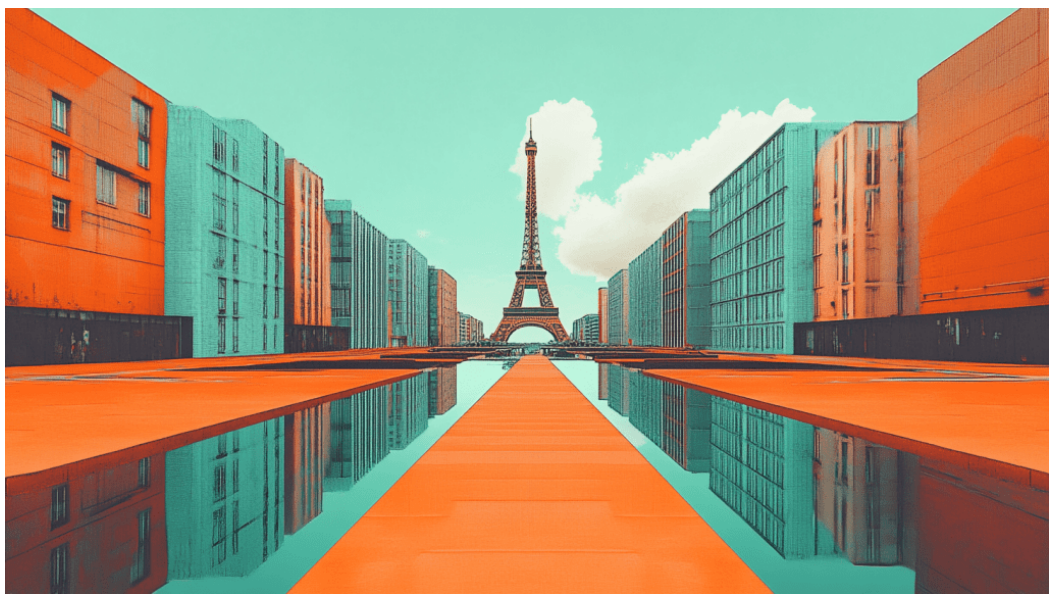


This was my base image. I wanted a symmetrical urban setting. I prioritized the colour orange.
